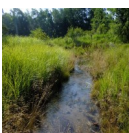

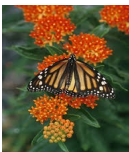

3. For All-One-Species (Single Species) Flats, click on the **Native Plant Sale** image, place order online and then **specify the species in Note to Seller at checkout**. Be sure to include your phone number.
4. You can browse specific species for the All-One-Species flats—or quarts—on the back of this brochure.
5. A variety of additional single species will be available in quart containers for purchase on site the day of the sale.

Why Native Plants?

- They adapt to poor quality soils due to their extensive root systems.
- They are drought tolerant.
- They out-compete weeds, yet are not aggressive.
- They require less maintenance.
- With proper installation practices, establishment can occur in less than 2 years.

Please note: We make every effort to provide specific species, but sometimes demand outstrips supply with native plants.
